

## **COMMITTEE MEMBER AUTHORITY**

Because all powers of the School Committee lie in its action as a group, individual Committee members exercise their authority over district affairs only as they vote to take action at a legal meeting of the Committee.

In other instances, an individual Committee member, including the chairman, has power only when the Committee by vote, has delegated authority to him or her.

No legal action can be taken except at a duly warned meeting of the Committee and by a quorum acting as a unit.

The decisions of the Committee shall be binding until rescinded by the Committee at a duly called regular or special meeting.
