

## **SCHOOL COMMITTEE LEGAL STATUS**

State law provides that public schools will be operated and maintained by local School Committees. As agents of the state government, School Committees are required to carry out state laws pertaining to public education, and to carry out the policies and regulations of the State Board of Education.

The Mohawk Trail Regional School District Committee is an instrument of the Massachusetts legislature and derives its authority from the Massachusetts constitution, Massachusetts Statutes, and regulations of the State Board of Education.
