

SUBMISSION AND APPROVAL OF THE SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

The written school improvement plan shall be submitted by the principal to the superintendent and the school committee for review and approval each year. Each school council shall submit its plan to the superintendent and to the Education subcommittee on or before May 15. The plan will be presented by council members at a school committee meeting. Along with a report on the progress on the previous year's goals. If the school improvement plan is not reviewed and discussed by the school committee within 30 days of this presentation to the committee, the plan shall be deemed to have been approved.

If the school improvement plan is reviewed but not approved by the superintendent and school committee, it shall be returned to the principal with specific comments as to the reason(s). The principal shall revise the plan in cooperation with the school council, and resubmit it prior to the opening of the school year, to be approved or returned for further consideration.
